Beautiful Savior is experiencing a significant time of growth. The Building Committee has helped to identify needs in our properties, but we don't only want to accommodate the present—we want to build for the future.

To help chart that course, the Church Council wants to hear from you, the Beautiful Savior family of faith. Over the next few months, members of the Council will be hosting a series of "town hall" meetings organized around the three phases of our congregation's mission: Rooted in Christ (worship), Growing in Faith (education and fellowship), and Branching Out in Love (service and outreach).
