### IN MEMORY OF REV. PAUL SCHMIDT

Rev. Paul M. Schmidt, 87, of Portland, Oregon was called to his eternal rest on Monday, March 26, 2018. He was born June 7, 1930, in Tinley Park, Illinois.

Pastor Schmidt was ordained July 31, 1955, and received his first call to serve from Our Savior Lutheran Church in Bingen, Washington from 1955-1958. He was then called to serve the following congregations: Hope in Greenacres, Washington 1959-1965; Christ in Murray, Utah 1965-1969; and Beautiful Savior in Spokane, Washington 1969-1986. In 1986 Pastor Schmidt was called to serve as the Associate Director of Missions for the Northwest District in Portland, and he served until he went on emeritus status in 1995. Pastor Schmidt continued serving during retirement, filling congregational vacancies and serving many congregations as an Intentional Interim Minister in Hawaii, Washington, and Oregon. He retired again in 2011, but continued to assist as needed at his home congregation of Trinity Lutheran in Oregon City.

Pastor Schmidt is survived by his wife of 60 years, Ernestine "Teny"; brother Robert Schmidt and sister Barbara Johnson; children David (Thuy), Joel (Daphne), Ann (Ben), and Daniel; 6 grandchildren, and 3 great-grandchildren.

Pastor Schmidt's memorial service will be on Saturday, April 28, at 11 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church, 16000 S Henrici Rd, Oregon City, OR 97045-7300. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be sent to Trinity Lutheran Church, Oregon City.
