BSLC VOTER'S MEETING

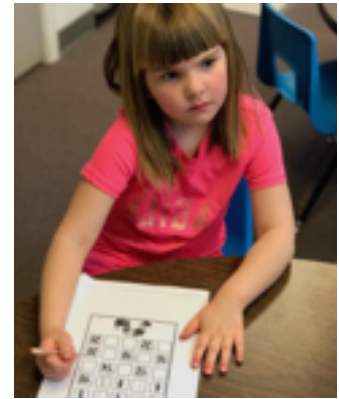
The Spring BSLC voter's meeting will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 25 following the 10:00 a.m. Divine Service. Please see information below regarding a proposed amendment to the bylaws you will be asked to vote on:

8.2.6 *This bylaw, relating to qualifications to serve as an elder, currently says: "Membership in the congregation as a "Voter" for at least two years."*

The Council recommends amending this bylaw by adding to the end of the sentence the words *"is recommended, but not required."* The Council believes that the 2-year membership requirement is desirable, but not strictly necessary, in view of the other requirements for service as an elder; additionally, the 2-year requirement unnecessarily restricts the number of individuals who otherwise qualify to serve as elders and who could serve well in that capacity.
