PROPOSED BY-LAWS AMENDMENT STEPHEN MINISTRY

8.4 Supervisory Board for Stephen Ministry Program

8.4.1 The Stephen Ministry Program, which provides individualized and confidential care to those undergoing life-changing circumstances, is an extension of the care and concern that is the responsibility of the Board of Elders.

8.4.2 The Stephen Ministry leader will attend a portion of the Board of Elders meetings to receive support, care requests and share (with the understanding that this ministry is highly confidential) general information about Stephen Ministry Program activities.

8.4.3 Stephen Ministry Program workers may receive care requests from the Pastor, Elders, or any member of the congregation.
