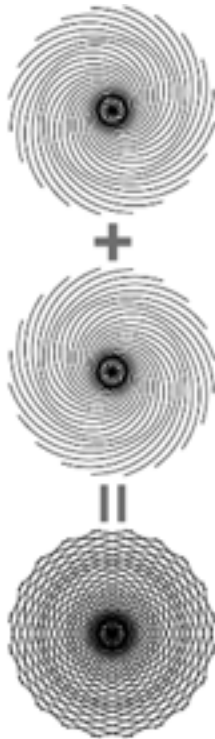
SCHOOL SHOES FOR KIDS DRIVE

IN THE GARDEN WITH TOM

God has his finger on everything. By this I am referring to something called the GOLDEN RATIO. Not a math person? I understand. However on closer observation, I have noticed more this year than others, the design flower blossoms produce. For example, the sunflower has a unique design. Mathematicians call this design the FIBONACCI SEQUENCE. On further observation there is a special relationship between the Golden RATIO and the FIBONACCI SEQUENCE (0, 1, 2, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 21... each number is the sum of the two numbers before it). Try counting the spiral arms - the "left turning" spirals, and then the "right turning" spirals... what numbers did you get? As God has design in all of creation, He has a design for our lives as well. Come visit the garden and enjoy the blossoms. While you are there, take in the Psalms. Bibles are located next to the garden entrance.

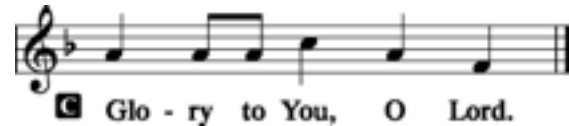
A Fibonacci Spiral is duplicated, rotated around the center, and the circular pattern is mirrored. When assembled the result forms the pattern seen in sunflowers.
