LUTHERHAVEN WOMAN'S RETREAT

March 20-22

This retreat will explore how to read the Psalms and prepare women to continue to sing the songs of God's people and for God's people. It will acknowledge the reasons why we need to sing, whether in times of joy or sorrow, confession or proclamation. As with all of the Old Testament, the psalms point us to the song of salvation whose chorus rings out from the mountains of Calvary.

Registration begins Friday at 4 PM and we wrap up around noon Sunday and the cost is \$183. That includes 2 night's lodging, 5 meals, and program (scholarships from BSLC are available to help offset the cost)
