LUTHERHAVEN WOMEN'S RETREAT

March 20-22

This retreat will explore how to read the Psalms and prepare women to continue to sing the songs of God's people and for God's people. As with all of the Old Testament, the psalms point us to the song of salvation whose chorus rings out from the mountains of Calvary.
